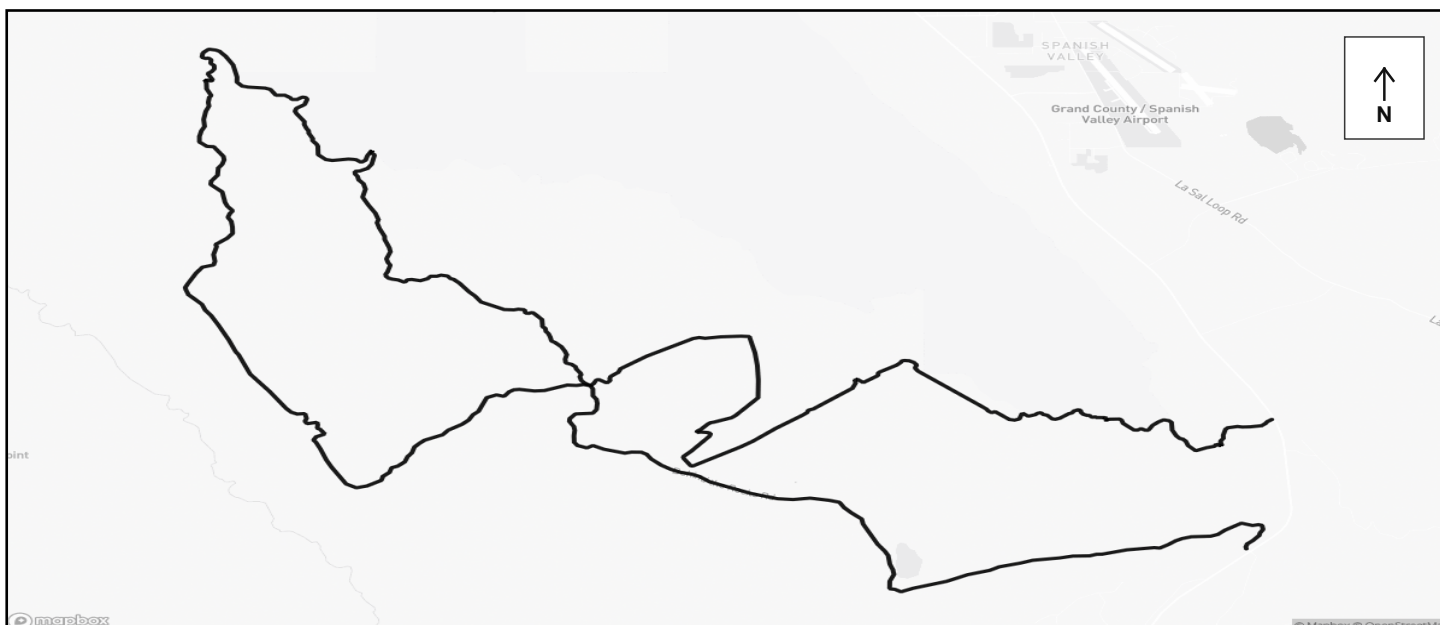

Description

A challenging and scenic Moab trail that blends classic slickrock driving with big, intimidating obstacles and wide-open desert views. The route winds through fins, sandy sections, and technical rock features, with optional lines that can significantly increase the difficulty. Signature obstacles like High Dive and White Knuckle Hill test both driver confidence and vehicle capability, with steep climbs and descents that demand careful line choice. While there are moments to catch your breath and enjoy the scenery, this trail leans technical overall and is best suited for well-equipped rigs and experienced drivers looking for a full-value Moab run. This is the published Red Rock 4-Wheelers route.
