## Description

The Crown King Trail is a classic Arizona backcountry route that climbs from the desert floor into pine forests, ending in the historic mining town of Crown King. The trail features a mix of rocky climbs, shelf roads, and water crossings, with conditions that can vary depending on weather and traffic. It's a long, rewarding drive that combines moderate technical sections with a true "destination trail" feel.

## Recommendations / Other Info

A bit of articulation for the obstacles! Most have bypasses. Watch for dirt bikes, as this trail can be very busy on the weekends!
