Description

A highly accessible dirt route just outside Reno that climbs from sagebrush-covered foothills into higher elevation terrain with sweeping views over the Truckee Meadows and surrounding mountains. The road itself is wide and generally well-maintained, making it a popular choice for everything from daily drivers to off-road vehicles, but its length, elevation gain, and occasional ruts or loose sections can still make for a fun and scenic climb. Multiple routes converge on the summit area, where radio towers sit atop Peavine Peak, and the trail network can become confusing due to the number of intersecting roads. While it lacks major technical obstacles, the real draw is the convenience, panoramic views, and year-round accessibility for a quick escape from the city.
